Helped hundreds of seniors and people with disabilities gain access to their Social Security benefits.

Ensured that Connecticut veterans were able to access their VA benefits and secure the medals earned during their service.



Worked with immigration officials to reunite families and process visas and green cards. Aided Connecticut travelers with issues abroad.

Aided families facing home foreclosure to help them stay in their houses and keep their utilities turned on.



Helped college students cut through red tape in order to access federal student loans and pell grants.

Fought to lower healthcare and drug costs for Connecticut seniors on Medicare.
