**A BILL**

To amend title 28, United States Code, to provide for a code of conduct for justices and judges of the courts of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supreme Court Ethics  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CODE OF CONDUCT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 57 of title 28, United  
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
9 lowing:

1 **“§ 964. Code of conduct**

2 “Not later than 1 year after the date of the enact-  
3 ment of this section, the Judicial Conference of the United  
4 States shall issue a code of conduct, which applies to each  
5 justice and judge of the courts of the United States, except  
6 that the code of conduct may include provisions that are  
7 applicable only to certain categories of judges or justices.”.

8 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—  
9 The table of sections for chapter 57 of title 28, United  
10 States Code, is amended by adding after the item related  
11 to section 963 the following:

“964. Code of conduct.”.
